The new Creek Technical Academy Magnet @ Coconut Creek High School opens on August 22, 2016. The technical academy is part of a partnership with Atlantic Technical High School and College. Students follow an intense academic track in grades 9 and 10, then split their time in grades 11 and 12 between academics and one of 29 technical programs, in which they will be career dual enrolled (CDE). Students in CDE classes earn the same points towards their grade point average as students in traditional dual enrollment or Advanced Placement classes. Graduates from the program will receive a high school diploma, at least one industry certification, and college credit. Among the many programs offered are emergency medical responder, emergency management, court reporting and transcription, architecture, construction, automotive technology, business management and administration, culinary arts, health science/medical, information technology, and manufacturing.
