H1N1 Vaccination Information in Broward County:

Public H1N1 vaccination sites are not open at this time in Broward County. Starting with the initial priority groups, H1N1 vaccinations are being offered to students at Broward County public schools. "Open" or public H1N1 Vaccination sites will be announced in the near future through the media, the Broward County Health Department website and other communication channels.

Private healthcare providers will begin to receive the vaccine over the course of the next few weeks.

H1N1 Vaccination at Broward County Schools:

At this time, H1N1 vaccinations are being offered to students in public schools in Broward County. The Broward County Health Department has also offered the vaccine to private and charter schools. Parents with children at private and charter schools must contact their school and inquire whether or not their school will be participating. If your child attends a school that is not participating, please contact your healthcare provider.
