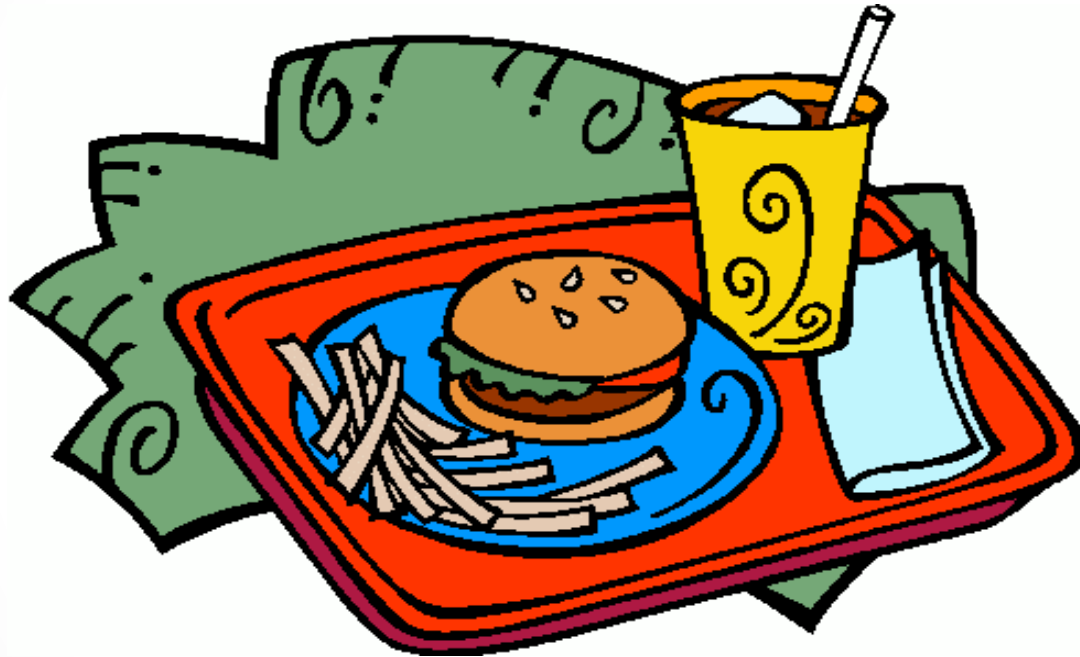


Adaptive Progress Monitoring (APM) Assessment
