EMERGENCY CODES

- ◆ **BROWN** – Chemical or biological incidents/threats
 - ◆ Evacuate facility based on the situation
- ◆ **BLACK** – Bomb threat
 - ◆ Evacuate facility based on the situation
- ◆ **BLUE** – Serious medical emergency
- ◆ **RED** – High priority critical incident, threat is imminent
 - ◆ No movement – Total lock down
- ◆ **YELLOW** – Medium priority critical incident
 - ◆ Limited movement – No bathroom/hall passes w/out security escort
- ◆ **GREEN** – All clear – resume normal activities

Consequences for Vaping in School



Vaping isn't just harmless water vapor!

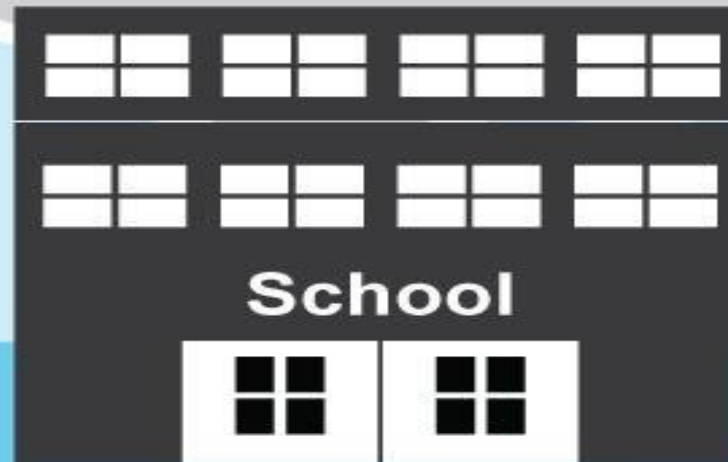
Elementary (K-5)

1st Offense: 1-day detention with a referral to the School Counselor
2nd and Subsequent Offenses: 1-2 day in-school suspension with a referral to the District Substance Abuse Case Manager

Secondary (6-12)

1st Offense: 1-2 day in-school suspension with required intervention assignments and a referral to the District Substance Abuse Case Manager
2nd Offense: 6-day suspension with required intervention program assignments and a referral to the District Substance Abuse Case Manager
3rd and Subsequent Offenses: 10-day suspension, recommendation for expulsion and a referral to the District Substance Abuse Case Manager

Vaping THC oils or similar substances may result in criminal charges.

CONSEQUENCES

6-12

1st Offense

1-2 day in-school suspension with required intervention assignments and a referral to the District Substance Abuse Case Manager

2nd Offense

6-day suspension with required intervention assignments and a referral to the District Substance Abuse Case Manager

3rd and Subsequent Offenses

10-day suspension, recommendation for expulsion, and a referral to the District Substance Abuse Case Manager
