Seminole Middle School's odd/even block schedule offers students the most challenging and enriching curriculum in Broward County. Students will attend a total of eight classes, four each day. Each block will be approximately 86 minutes in length. This innovative schedule will allow students to experience elective and enrichment courses that they normally would not have room for in a traditional middle school schedule. It also gives core subject teachers the opportunity to focus and explore their content curriculum. Student schedules are customized to suit individual educational needs and explore their varied interests. The Apprentice, Creative Writing, Theme Park Engineering, Starfleet Academy, and Web Design are just a few of the many high interest enrichment courses designed to develop students in the areas of reading, math, writing and science.

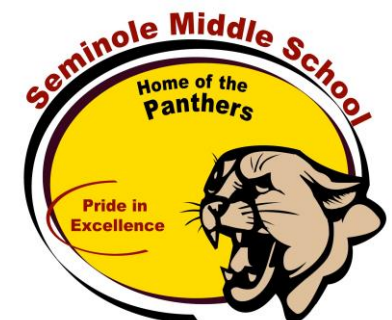
