


THE CAMBRIDGE CURRICULUM

 - F=0 PTS

- AP, AICE AND DE COURSE:
 - A=6 PTS
 - B=5 PTS
 - C=4 PTS
 - D=1 PT
 - F=0 PTS

WHICH GPA DO THEY USE?

- YOUR UWEIGHTED GPA
 - GRADUATION
 - PARTICIPATION
- THE WEIGHTED GPA
 - SCHOOL RANK
 - INDICATOR OF COMPETITIVE STANDING
- THE CORE GPA
 - ONLY LOOKS AT ENGLISH, MATH, SOCIAL STUDIES, SCIENCE AND WORLD LANGUAGES
 - GIVES A SMALL BONUS FOR HONORS/AP/AICE/DE COURSES
 - MOST SIMILAR TO BRIGHT FUTURES AND STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM GPA

CAMBRIDGE PROGRESSION AT EHS

- YOU HAVE THREE YEARS TO PASS SEVEN COURSES FOR THE AICE DIPLOMA
 - IF A STUDENT BEGINS AICE COURSES IN 9TH GRADE, THEY MUST FINISH BY 11TH GRADE.
 - IF A STUDENT BEGINS AICE COURSES IN 10TH GRADE, THEY MUST FINISH BY 12TH GRADE.
- OPTIONS:
 - TYPICAL PROGRESSION: 2 COURSES (10TH), 3 COURSES (11TH), 2 COURSES (12TH)
 - FAST TRACK PROGRESSION: 2 COURSES (9TH); 3 COURSES (10TH), 2 COURSES (11TH)
 - AS LONG AS STUDENTS COMPLETE IN THREE SCHOOL YEARS, THEY CAN EARN THE DIPLOMA
