



After-School Detention Policy

After-school detentions may be issued to students who are in violation of the Code of Conduct or school-wide procedures, including but not limited to:

Dress Code Violations
Habitual Tardiness
Hall Sweeps
Skipping Class

Detentions will be held on Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 4:30 – 6 p.m. Students must be present, and seated in the Internal Suspension Room (T-21) by 4:30 p.m. **sharp**. Students will not be allowed to enter the detention room after 4:30 p.m., and will subsequently receive an unserved detention. Afternoon transportation will not be provided for students who are issued a detention.

Unserved Detentions

*Failure to serve an after-school detention will result in the following consequences:

- 1st Unserved Detention: 1 additional detention
- 2nd Unserved Detention: 2 additional detentions
- 3rd Unserved Detention: 1 Full Day Internal Suspension
- 4th Unserved Detention: Parent conference with grade level administrator / behavior intervention / progressive discipline

* Detentions will accumulate, but will not be carried over into the second semester

Detention Policies and Student Expectations

- Parents will receive a courtesy call to notify them of their child's detention
- Detentions supersede extra curricular activities
- Students must report to detention and be seated by 4:30 p.m.
- Students are expected to be seated quietly, without the use of any cell phones, music, electronic games, etc.
- SLEEPING is not permitted
- Students are expected to complete academic assignments or read quietly
- The *teacher* is responsible for taking attendance, and dismissing students at the end of the detention

Violation of these expectations will result in an unserved detention!
