Cypress Bay High School Student Parking and Driving Policies

1. All students must have a valid driver's license. (Learners permits are not acceptable)
2. Student's vehicles are subject to search at any time while on school property. Since parking and operating a student vehicle on campus is a privilege, violation of any of the student policies may result in the following:
 - Suspension of driving privilege
 - Loss of parking and operating privilege
 - Citation by Broward Sheriff's Office
 - Removal of violator's vehicle by tow truck at owner's expense
3. Vehicles parked without an official CBHS parking decal will be towed away at owner's expense.
4. Parking permits are not transferable to another student's vehicle.
 - Anyone who makes copies or allows copies of their parking decal to be made will have their parking privileges revoked.
 - Anyone caught in the possession of a fraudulent or stolen parking decal will be suspended from school for 3 days and will not be allowed to purchase a decal for the remainder of the school year.
5. Parking privileges will be revoked due to violations of student code of conduct including excessive absenteeism.
6. If the parking decal is lost, stolen, damaged or altered in any way, a new parking decal, if any remain, must be purchased at \$57.50.
7. School Board Policy 5307: "The board of public instruction shall not be responsible for damage to automobiles or other vehicles which are parked or operated on school property." Report any damage to Security immediately.
8. Parking must be in the authorized student parking area only. Students will park in their assigned, numbered spot and not park in any other spot. Violations are subject to having your parking privileges revoked.
9. Do not play car radios loudly. Keep in compliance with city ordinances. The speed limit on campus is 10 mph. Violators will be ticketed and/or lose parking privileges.
10. Students are only permitted in parking area during immediate arrival and departure from school. No loitering is permitted in parking lot during school hours.
