





Unified Dress Code

Greetings Parents,

Pasadena Lakes Elementary will be a uniform school beginning with the 2019-2020 school year. Students are to adhere to the dress code as stated in the Code of Student Conduct Handbook. For dress code information please read below.

UNIFORMS INCLUDE:

SHIRTS:

Solid color "Polo Style" Shirt (short or long sleeve)

Colors: Teal, Gray, Black, Navy Blue or White.

SHORTS, PANTS OR OVERALLS:

Long or knee length short pants (no jeans)

Colors: Navy Blue, Khaki or Black

JUMPERS, SKIRTS, SKORTS OR CULOTTES:

Knee length, pleated or unpleated tennis skirts with shorts attached

Colors: Navy Blue, Khaki or Black

SHOES: As per the Broward County School Board Dress Code Policy.

Items may be purchased at any locations that sell standard uniforms.

In addition, all students are required to adhere to the dress code requirements as stated in the Broward County School Code of Conduct at all times.

Exemptions to the Mandatory Unified Dress Code Program:

An exemption from a mandatory unified dress code program may be granted within the first 10 school days of a student's initial attendance when the uniform violates a sincerely held religious belief, freedom of expression rights, or other reason so designated by the parent or guardian. Exemptions may also be given for uniforms associated with scouting, etc. on designated meeting days and for special clothing worn for a school activity.

Parents/guardians may request an exemption for their students from the current school year. An application for exemption must be completed in full and submitted to the school principal within the first ten (10) school days of a student's initial attendance. The school principal or a designated administrator may communicate with the parents to discuss the uniform policy and the nature of the request for exemption. The purpose of the communication shall include ensuring parents/guardians understand the uniform policy and its intent or verifying the accuracy of the information on the form. The principal's response in this regard shall be transmitted to the parents/guardians via the Application for Exemption form within ten (10) school days of submission. Exemptions will be granted when the aforementioned procedures are followed.
