

Course Progression

Attucks Middle is a Block Schedule School. As such, each year students will have the opportunity to complete 4 core classes and 4 elective classes based on their FSA scores, grades, and interests.

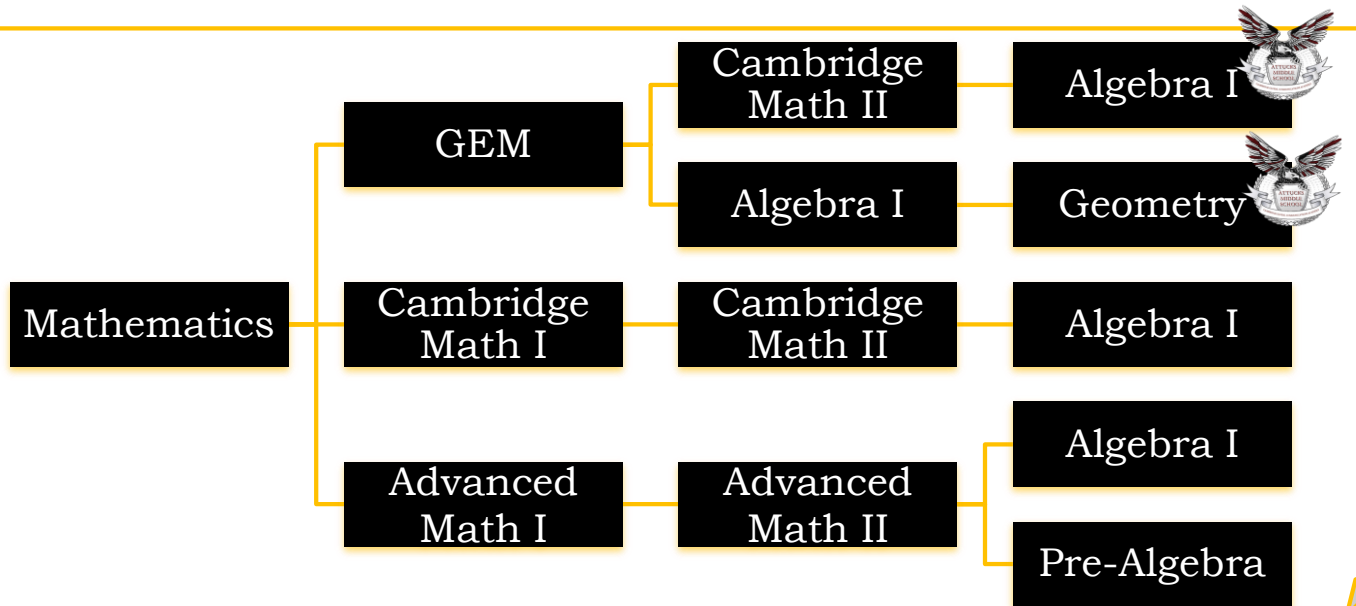
The 8 classes are covered over the course of two days:

Maroon covering periods 1-4

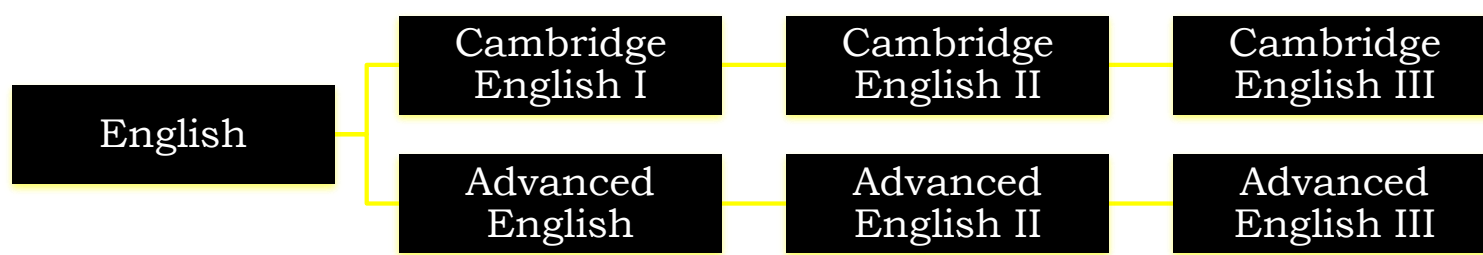
Silver covering periods 5-8

Below is an idea of how courses can progress from 6th to 8th grade for students with FSA scores of 3-5 and GPAs of 2.0 and above.

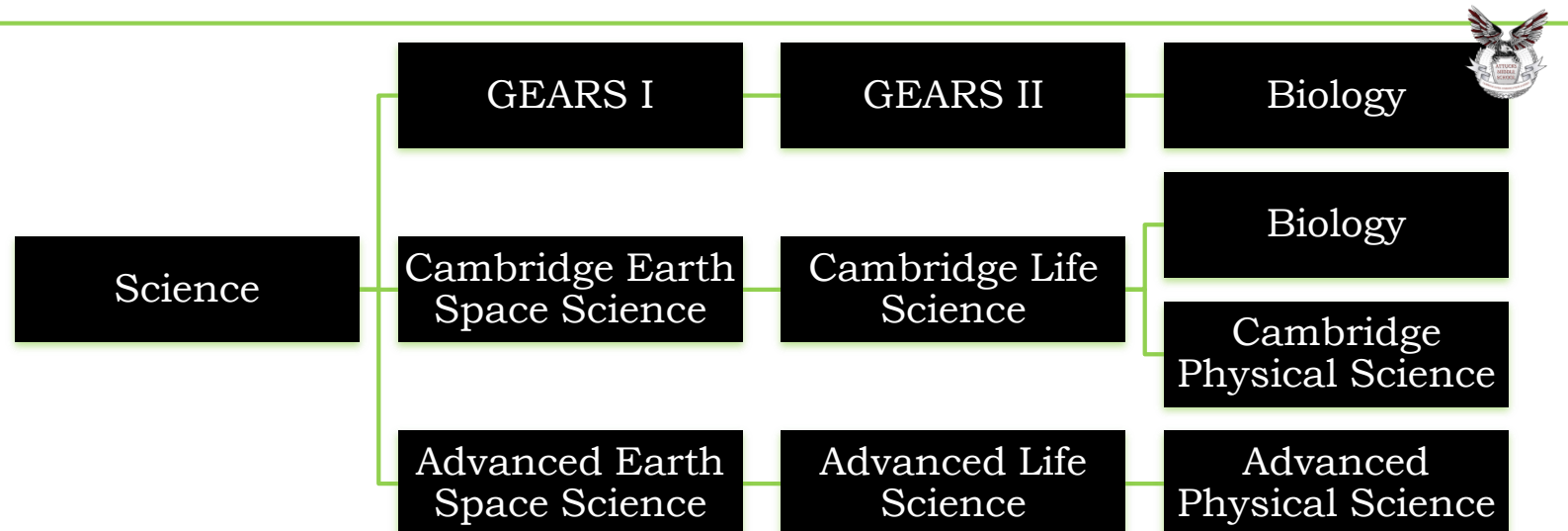
Students must complete and pass the GEM exam in 5th grade in order to be placed in the GEM course. Students who do not pass the GEM exam may be placed in Cambridge or Advanced Math classes based on their FSA scores and school grades. Maintenance of impeccable grades and work ethic will allow for the following pathway:



Student FSA scores and GPAs will determine the level of English Language Arts or ELA in which they will be placed:



Student FSA scores and GPAs will determine the level of Science in which they will be placed:



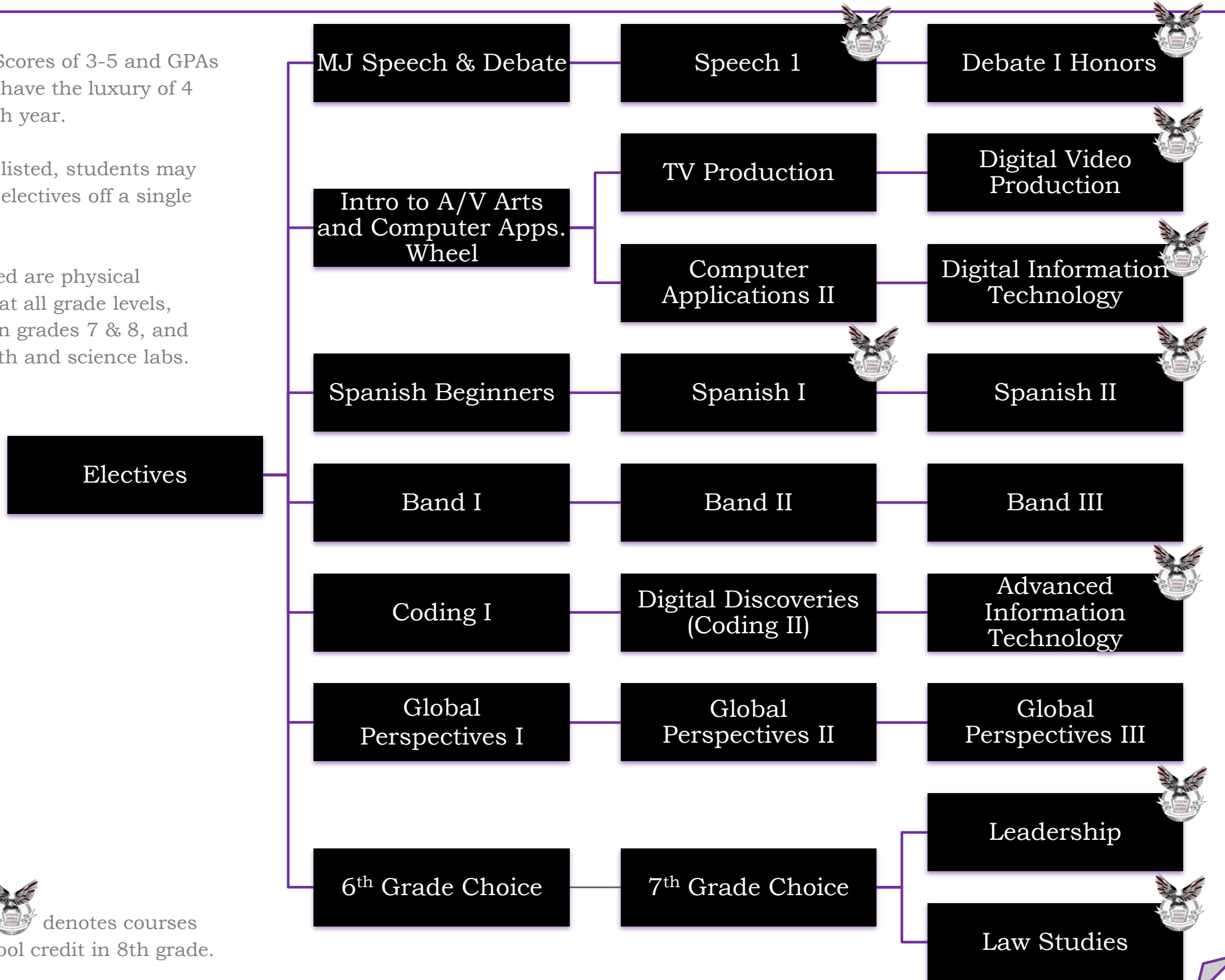
Student FSA ELA and GPA scores will determine the level of Social Studies in which they will be placed:



Students with FSA Scores of 3-5 and GPAs of 2.0 or higher will have the luxury of 4 elective classes each year.

While pathways are listed, students may experience different electives off a single pathway.

Electives not included are physical education available at all grade levels, yearbook available in grades 7 & 8, and elective reading, math and science labs.
