The Broward County Public Schools Debate Initiative is a partnership between local businesses and K-12 debate programs within Broward County. With over 15,000 students actively participating, it is the largest debate program in the nation.

WHY DEBATE?

Speech and debate students learn research, logic, organization of ideas, manipulation of language, assessment of audience, self-esteem, and engagement in world events. These skills not only build better students, they build better college candidates, better employees and better citizens.

Increases literacy scores by 25%

Increases GPAs by 10%

98% of debate students graduate from high school and 95% attend a four-year college

Helps first generation students get recruited and receive scholarships to college

Increases an at-risk student's chance of graduating high school by 70%


