Dear Parents/Guardians of a Gifted Child or Children:

Pompano Beach High School will be hosting a two-week camp this summer for 240 gifted and intellectually talented children. Gifted students who are entering grades 3 through 8 for the 2019 - 2020 school year are eligible to apply. The cost of the camp will be \$300.00 for the two weeks. Full and partial scholarships will be available based upon free / reduced lunch criteria and availability of funds. Payment will be due at time of selection.

For those parents not able to pick their camper up at 3:30pm we will be offering a sports enrichment program each camp day from 3:30 – 5:30PM for an additional fee of \$100.00. (Excluding the last day of camp – August 1st)

Pompano Beach High School's Summer Camp for the Gifted will provide a learning environment that values and enhances the gifted student's ability, creativity, and passion for learning. Transportation and meals will not be provided.

Grades 3-5 will be exposed to each of the following:

- Creative Writing
- Robotics
- Logic Puzzles
- S.T.E.M. (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math Course)
- Marine Biology

Grades 6-8 will select two of the following courses:

- Coding
- Marine Biology
- Sports History
- Journalism
- DNA /Genetics
- Physics & Rockets
- Mechanical & Electrical Engineering
- Robotics
- Survey of Math History

Each camper (**Grades 3-8**) will also select a Humanities course. A list of these courses can be found within the application packet.

Interested parents should send their completed application to Pompano Beach High School. The deadline for applications is February 28, 2019. Once all applications are processed a committee will select up to forty students at each grade level to attend the camp. Decision notifications will be sent by March 31, 2019.
