



GPA Boosting Tips

- Sign up for the following FLVS courses & select Broward Virtual as your school: Drivers education, Critical Thinking & Study Skills, & Career Research & Decision Making, Peer Counseling, Social Media & Parenting Skills.
- Log on to your Virtual Counselor to recover any core classes that received a “D” or “F” via night school.
- If you received a “C” while in middle school that was a high school course, such as Alg, Bio, Geometry, Spanish, French, or etc. You can make these up!
- Take an honors course for subjects you do well in! (English to English Honors).
- Take an AP course if you have a level 4 reading level &/or do well in a current Honors course! (English Honors- AP English)
- Select the same electives next year! Most level 2 & level 3 electives turn into honors!
- If you are fluent in French, Creole, or Spanish, take an AP Foreign language class.
- Attend tutoring in media center after school Monday-Thursday 2:45-3:45.
- Attend tutoring via 21st century (See Mr. Brown or grade level counselor).
- Use Study Hall to focus on lowest grades first.
- Use your Study Hall to complete FLVS classes.
- Arrive on time for all your classes!
- “Early bird gets the worm”- start off each quarter strong by completing assignments on time.
- Invest in a planner & stay up to date with upcoming assignments & due dates.
- Use your cell phones to setup your calendar and reminders.
- Ask your teacher if they use apps such as “remind, canvas, or etc” to stay up to date on assignments.
