Reading Across Broward

While your child is reading for the Principal's Reading Challenge, don't forget to keep track of the book titles on the Reading Across Broward Reading Record Sheet. Reading Across Broward is a county-wide motivational reading program developed by the Superintendent of Broward County Schools. This is the Broward Superintendent's Reading Motivation Project that recognizes children for the number of books they read throughout the year. Reading Across Broward is an enrichment activity for parents and children to share at home. It will be each parent's responsibility to keep accurate records. The program runs from April of one year until the end of March the next year. Reading Across Broward is currently underway in the county and runs until March 31 of next year. Any book read since last April, including summer reading, may be used on the form. Completed forms are due to your child's classroom teacher no later than April 1, 2020.

Students in any grade may participate. Students are encouraged to read a wide variety of literature from different categories and genres.

Students may independently read the books or have them read to them. Every child is welcome to participate, and everyone receives recognition for his or her achievements. Awards are given based on the number of books read. Each level has different requirements for completion. The different categories of accomplishment for each level are explained on the Reading Across Broward form. There are two levels of participation and separate reading record sheets are available for each level. Reading Across Broward forms are available online as pdfs. Remember to print both sides. Our school is implementing a program called *i-Ready® Diagnostic & Instruction* that will provide our students in grades K-5 with an innovative diagnostic assessment and engaging instruction. The focus of this online program is reading. *i-Ready Diagnostic & Instruction* helps teachers to effectively assess their students and then provide individualized instruction based on each student's unique needs.

i-Ready Diagnostic & Instruction assesses and teaches the following skill areas:


Reading

- Phonological Awareness
- Phonics
- High-Frequency Words
- Vocabulary
- Comprehension

It is highly recommended that your child work on the i-Ready lessons at home. To log into i-Ready, your child will need to access the county's Single Site Sign On

(<u>SSO.BROWARDSCHOOLS.COM</u>) and log into their Clever account.


Our Annual Fall Festival will be October 25th from 6-8pm
