Hello families, Thank you for taking time to read this spooooky edition of our newsletter! Does your child know the difference between fiction and nonfiction? Ask them to tell you the genre of the book they are reading. It's important for them to understand what they are reading and the purpose for reading it! We have been studying characters and the challenges they face. Take time to make connections with them. Talk about their favorite book or even cartoon. What challenges does the main character face? How do they solve their problems?

Happy Halloween from Second Grade!

Our 1st Graders are working on: Sight daily from home.

Words, Parts of speech (nouns, adjectives, verbs, /L/ word blends). Reading Target Skills (Identifying Story Elements, Character Traits, Fiction and Nonfiction books). Math -Addition & Subtraction Strategies (Numbers 1-20) (Doubles, Count On, Doubles plus one, Doubles Minus One) - Subtraction Strategies (Numbers 1-20). Parents remember to read to or with your child and have your child read to you daily. Ask comprehension questions (Who, What, When, Where, and How). Practice sight words (Dolch Sight Words can be found at: https://sightwords.com/sightwords/dolch/#lists. Students can also enhance their academic skill by logging into i-Ready (Reading & Math) and Reflexmath

We have been continuing to study and memorize our multiplication facts as we are moving towards division and learning about fact families. We have been learning about point of view and author's perspective. We read and discussed different versions of The Three Little Pigs and Cinderella. We learned that there are different sides to a story and that everyone has their own opinions. This week we learned about maps and used various mapping skills to investigate and practice. We even got to create our own treasure maps using our skills! Continue to read every night and record your minutes on Beanstack for Mr. Gerlach's reading challenge and use Reflex to help with your multiplication facts.

Dear Parents.

Kindergarten is working on the following skills:

Reading: Concepts of Print, phonemic and phonological awareness, sight words, identify rhyming words, blend and segment syllables in spoken words, identify the initial, medial and final sound of spoken words, distinguish between important and unimportant information about characters, describe important events in a story, use main characters and important events to retell a story and enhance comprehension, identify and explain descriptive words in a text, and identify and explain characters feeling and actions and explain the roles of Author and Illustrator of a story.

Math: Given a group of up to 10 objects, count the number of objects in the group and represent the number of objects with a written numeral.

Writing: Print upper and lowercase letters and correct letter formation, draw, dictate. and/or write to create a narrative with events in chronological order, illustrating ideas and learning to write simple sentences.

Grammar: Using question words, and form and use regular plural nouns Sincerely,
