



 - 2. Diploma Pathway- Obtaining Cambridge Diploma






Total of seven credits required for Diploma

Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) Diploma requirements




- *Combines breadth of study with choice and flexibility*

- *Passing scores are required on all exams to receive Diploma*







Why do Admissions Officers rate Cambridge so highly?





We wanted to find out what university admissions staff around the world look for when selecting candidates. We also wanted to get their views about Cambridge programmes and qualifications, in particular how well they feel they prepare students for university study. We produced an online survey, supplemented with telephone interviews, and had responses from 130 higher education admissions staff in 10 countries, including the USA, UK, Australia and Canada. 






Can I take the AP Capstone program and Cambridge? *Yes, and we can work on a schedule to do both.*




When do students take AICE examinations?

The majority of our students will take AICE examinations in May/June. Testing dates are posted. Please see your teacher or Ms. Megna, our testing coordinator, if you have any questions. Please note, some AICE examinations take **place after the regular school year has ended**, but absolutely are still required.

What if I miss an AICE examination?

There is no make-up examination within the same testing session; therefore, the candidate would need to retake the test the following session in the next school year
