


Overview

The MI Advantage assessment uses Multiple Intelligences theory to reveal your intelligence strengths and challenges, and then provides suggestions on way to develop all these intelligences.

There are 72 questions in the assessment and you can stop and save your progress at any time. The results of MI Advantage include strategies to make the most of your intelligences.

Step 1: Accessing the Task

1. To get started, **click on My Planner**. Then **click on Tasks** to view the tasks you need to complete.




2. Select **Complete MI Advantage** under Tasks You Need to Work On.



3. There are several action items available after you click the task. **You can:**

- **Add a comment** if you would share a viewpoint/remark with your counselor.
- **Upload a document** (Drop Files or Click to Browse...).
- **Add To-Dos** if there is an action item you need to create.
- **Raise Hand** (Ask a question) which emails your counselor directly




Your Profile
