TIPS FOR ENTERING SCHOLARSHIPS INTO YOUR BROWARD GRADUATION SURVEY:



We want to make sure that your award data is accurate. Please take a moment to review these guidelines.

- Enter only scholarships that you have been <u>awarded</u> and are <u>planning to use</u>.
 <u>Example 1</u>: You will definitely attend FSU but were offered merit money from USF. Do not enter the USF money offered, since you will not use it.
 <u>Example 2</u>: Scholarships from organizations, churches, temples, employers, colleges/universities, athletic departments.
- DO NOT enter scholarships that you have applied for and are waiting to hear about. Scholarships received later can be added! Ask your BRACE Advisor to reopen your survey for editing.
- Enter the <u>total dollar amount</u> of each scholarship <u>without dollar signs, commas or periods</u>! <u>Example:</u> Enter sixteen thousand dollars as 16000 (not \$16,000).
- Is the scholarship a <u>one-time award</u> or is it <u>renewable</u>? List the TOTAL VALUE for each scholarship that you have been awarded.
 <u>Example 1</u>: If you were awarded a \$1000 scholarship that is renewable for 4 years, enter the TOTAL scholarship as 4000 (1000 x 4 = 4000).
 <u>Example 2</u>: If you were awarded a \$1000 scholarship that cannot be renewed, enter 1000.
- Please DO NOT include Bright Futures Scholarships in this section. You should have already entered it in Question #11 in the survey.
- Please do not enter Pell Grants, Federal Work-Study or Loans. This money is financial aid, not scholarships.
