The Gloria M. Education and awareness is saving lives, and over 5,000 girls and women have already been assisted in their time of need.

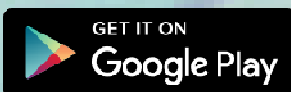

Talking Points

Create a Safe Haven awareness video via your smart phone - up to 12 hours

Get creative and create a video focusing on creating awareness about A Safe Haven for Newborns.

- Research Subject: A Safe Haven for Newborns
- Create overall message and video title
- Create story line
- Choose location/date/time for production
- Select actors and actresses
- Identify and obtain necessary props, graphics, and ASHFNB logo
- Determine sound effects and music
- Video production
- Video editing and create final product

Participate in Safe Haven speaker bureaus - up to 8 hours

We welcome anyone who is interested in making presentations to organizations or groups in your community.

Average length of a presentation is 30-minutes including a Q&A session. All materials for your presentation will be provided.

1. Research Subject: A Safe Haven for Newborns
2. Familiarize yourself with the presentation content provided by ASHFNB
3. Identify an organization for your presentation
4. Contact them and schedule the speaking engagement
5. Verify engagement details via email with the individual authorizing the speaking engagement, your contact person if different, confirm date, time and location and expected attendance
6. After the presentation, take a photo of you and the person authorizing the presentation or contact person
7. Submit photo along with email verifying engagement details



Create a Safe Haven social media campaign - up to 15 hours

1. Develop a social media campaign on the various social media sites to create more awareness of A Safe Haven for Newborns.
2. Research Subject: A Safe Haven for Newborns
3. Select social media sites to include at a minimum; Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, Google + and Tumblr
4. Plan your imagery
5. Consider incorporating a video in your campaign (ASHFNB will provide)
6. Plan the content you will post and share
7. Create a 14 day content posting calendar
Facebook- 1 POST PER DAY All others- 2 posts per day
8. Coordinate the content posting and calendar with ASHFNB
9. Use Google Analytics to track activity performance
10. Submit social media site results to ASHFNB
