SPORTING EVENT PROCEDURES

- ★ All athletes, spectators, and parents picking up athletes should ONLY use the 172nd Avenue student parking lot and are to access the stadium or gym from the west side of the school.
- ★ The only access to the gym for wrestling matches or basketball games will be from a single door at the front of the gymnasium.
- ★ Backpacks will be prohibited in the gym during games, as well as bags or purses larger than 12 inches X 12 inches. Diaper bags are allowed but will be subject to search.
- ★ Re-entry will not be permitted to any sporting event.
- ★ Ticket purchases will not be allowed after the start of the fourth quarter of the final basketball game of the evening.

See Something. Hear Something. Say Something.

In an emergency, call 911 immediately. To submit a safety concern that is not urgent, you can do so anonymously. Help identify and intervene with at-risk individuals BEFORE they hurt themselves or others by reporting non-urgent threats, harassing behaviors, illegal activity (vandalism, theft, the sale of drugs), as well as information about planned crimes.

How do you make an anonymous report? There are many ways to provide a tip, just follow the directions below.

Download and Use the SaferWatch App

Download the SaferWatch App at saferwatchapp.com/browardschools. This app gives users in Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) a direct line to communicate with local law enforcement and the BCPS Special Investigative Unit (SIU) about incidents or concerns.

Download and Use the FortifyFL App

Download the FortifyFL App at getfortifyfl.com. Use any electronic smart device to anonymously report unsafe, potentially harmful, dangerous, violent or criminal activities, or the threat of these activities to the appropriate law enforcement agency and school official.

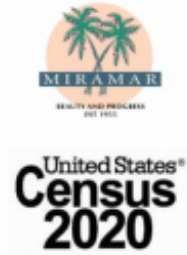

The City Of Miramar serves over 21 Broward County public schools, with more than 50,000 students and teachers. City Of Miramar student population is multicultural with many needs and this is reflected in our student population. These populations are among the hardest to count in a census.

All students are invited to participate, sharing their knowledge

Rules and Guidelines

1. All entries must be a digital video.
2. Each entry must focus on the 2020 US Census and include hashtag
 - **#OneMiramar**
 - **#MakeYourselfCount**
 - **#ShapeYourFutureStartHere**
3. Students may submit work as a class
4. The length of the video should not exceed 60 seconds (one minute),
5. All entries should begin with a 5 second full-screen "title screen" that includes the following information:
 - Lead Producer's name
 - School name
 - Title of video
 - Total running time (not including the 5 second title screen)
6. There is no entry fee.

7. Entries may be submitted via email between **March 1 – 12, 2020**. The deadline for submissions is 5:00 pm (eastern time, US) on Thursday, March 12, 2020. Winners will be announced no later than Thursday, March 19, 2020. **Emails should be sent to Michelle McKoy: mlmckoy@miramarfl.gov**
8. All entries must be submitted in digital format on Youtube. MP4 files or a Youtube link from your own channel is acceptable.
9. No copyrighted materials (music, images, etc.) may be used for this contest unless you own the copyright or have a license to use the material for this contest. Written permission must be obtained and provided upon request for all copyrighted materials.
10. No professional assistance is allowed. Adults may assist with production but are limited to verbal guidance only. Adults are allowed to be actors or cameramen but not content contributors.
11. All portions of the online entry form must be completed when you upload your video for it to be eligible.
12. IF CHOSEN AS A FINALIST you must submit a signed/completed **Parent Permission Form** and a signed/completed **Actor Release Form** for each person appearing in your video. Forms can be scanned/emailed to: mlmckoy@miramarfl.gov. The City has full usage rights to broadcast the winning videos.
13. Awards will be presented as follows:

- The winning class gets their video screened on City of Miramar TV
- Receive a certificate of recognition from the City of Miramar
- Recognition on National Census Day, April 1 at the City of Miramar Commission Meeting
