## FOOD DELIVERY PROHIBITED

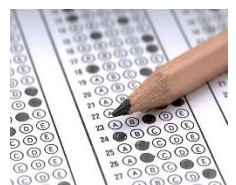


Unauthorized visitors are not allowed on the property of Broward County Public Schools for the delivery of student ordered commercial meals. Broward County Public Schools are closed campuses.

# See Something. Hear Something. Say Something.

In an emergency, call 911 immediately. To submit a safety concern that is not urgent, you can do so anonymously. Help identify and intervene with at-risk individuals BEFORE they hurt themselves or others by reporting non-urgent threats, harassing behaviors, illegal activity (vandalism, theft, the sale of drugs), as well as information about planned crimes.

### Download and Use the SaferWatch App

Download the SaferWatch App at [saferwatchapp.com/browardschools](http://saferwatchapp.com/browardschools). This app gives users in Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) a direct line to communicate with local law enforcement and the BCPS Special Investigative Unit (SIU) about incidents or concerns.



### Download and Use the FortifyFL App

Download the FortifyFL App at [getfortifyfl.com](http://getfortifyfl.com). Use any electronic smart device to anonymously report unsafe, potentially harmful, dangerous, violent or criminal activities, or the threat of these activities to the appropriate law enforcement agency and school official.
