DUAL ENROLLMENT

The process for Dual Enrollment and Early Admissions has change for the Spring term. If you would like to be a part of Broward College's Dual Enrollment Program, you must follow the specific steps Broward College has put forth. Everything is to be completed ONLINE and Continuing students must complete and follow the same procedures for every semester.

The DEADLINE for Spring 2021 semester is 3:00 pm on October 1st, 2020.

Step 1-Do I qualify?

-you must have an unweighted GPA of a 3.0 or higher AND must pass the Accuplacer Next Generation (no more PERT) OR have met the following Test scores, you can mix and match.

Step 2-Scores vs No scores

- -If you have the above test scores, click on "How to Get Started" and follow Broward College's instructions verbatim.
- -If you do not have the above test scores and want to participate, you MUST remotely take the Accuplacer Next Generation Exam to qualify and pass all sections in English, Reading, and Math.

Please complete the following Test Request and your School Counselor will notify Broward College.

In 5 to 7 days, the Testing Center will email your test voucher. Students, you MUST check your Broward College email for notification. Please plan accordingly as your testing request will NOT be processed after September 25th due to Broward College deadlines. Once you have the passing scores, please click

on "How to Get Started" and follow Broward College's instructions verbatim.

-If you do not pass the Accuplacer, complete the Test Request and you can retest. After the 2nd testing attempt, you must wait 30 days before re-testing

Step 3-Broward College Recommendations

- -You can only submit 1 Dual Enrollment Form
- -You must fill out the form carefully and will need parent approval by indicating their email address (your

parent/guardian) will then approve your form prior to the School Counselor.

- -You must submit the form prior by October 1st
- -You must actively check your BC email account

Step 4-Completion

After you have completed the Dual Enrollment form, Broward College will notify you through your BC account and indicate your Dual Enrollment status.

Step 5-BC Registrations starts 10/28 on their website **Grades 9-10**: May take one* DE course per semester at BC or UF for a maximum total of two courses during the school year and one summer course. The DE class may be taken on the college campus, on the high school campus, or online.

Grade 11: May take two* total DE courses per semester at BC, UF, or any combination of those schools for a maximum total of four courses during the school year and one summer course. Both DE courses may be taken on the high school campus or if the student takes take one DE course on the college campus or online then the second DE course must be taken on the high school campus.

Grade 12: May take three* total DE courses per semester at BC, UF, or any combination of those schools for a maximum total of six courses during the school year. All DE courses may be taken on the high school campus; however, students may take a maximum of two DE courses on the college campus or online and the remaining DE course(s) must be taken on the high school campus.

- *Courses with a required lab are considered one course, even though the lab is a separate course for registration purposes.
- -Early Admissions students must take 12 credits each term during their senior year
- -Your total number of Dual Enrollment classes plus your **Everglades High School classes must equal 8 classes.** (Example: 2 DE courses plus 5 EHS courses and 1 EHS study hall = 8 total courses.)

Grab-and-Go meals are available for students at all Elementary, Middle and High Schools starting on Wednesday, August 19th, then every Tuesday and Thursday from 11 AM - 1 PM and 3 PM - 5 PM. Students or their parents will be able to pick up multiple meals at a time by walking or driving to the car or bus loop. It is strongly recommended that students or their parents pick up student meals at their home school for ease of service.

Parents must have identification for their student to pick up meals if the student is not present. Recommended forms of identification include student ID's, report cards, and birth certificates. Identification must be present at each meal service.

Broward County Public Schools offers Universal Free Breakfast for all students. Meal prices will be based on each student's meal eligibility status. Apply for Free and Reduced priced meals at myschoolapps.com. Families are encouraged to pay online for student meals through myschoolbucks.com. Price per meal for BCPS students are as follows:
