Suspicious Activity Reporting App

Now, any student, educator, parent, or member of the public can report school safety concerns directly to law enforcement and school administrators anonymously and easily through the FortifyFL app or [www.getfortifyfl.com](http://www.getfortifyfl.com). The app, which is available for download on Apple and Android mobile devices, is critical to ensuring all Florida schools are safe environments where students and educators can experience and share the joy of learning without fear. We hope that you will become familiar with this tool and help us spread the word about it with our students and their families.

### Broward County Public Schools Updated Camera Policy

During distance learning, the use of student cameras is required for attendance and instruction. Students will be counted in attendance in the learning environment during their scheduled class time. Teachers should be flexible and consider any extenuating circumstances of individual students who may be unable to turn on a camera. Teachers may consider other evidence of attendance for individual cases.

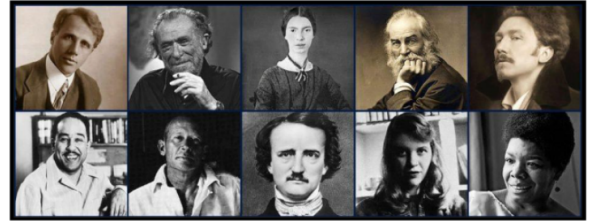

## Fort Lauderdale High School



The **Cambridge AICE Diploma** is awarded to learners who pass a minimum of seven Cambridge exams in THREE academic years. All students must pass AS Global Perspectives & Research, and at least one credit must be earned in each subject group (group 4 is optional). The remaining credits can come from any of the groups.

### GLOBAL PERSPECTIVES AND RESEARCH- MANDATORY

The Cambridge International AS & A Level Global Perspectives and Research syllabus is based on skills rather than on specific content. Learners develop research, thinking, reasoning and communication skills by following an approach to analysing and evaluating arguments and perspectives called the Critical Path.
