FSA/EOC EXAMS

The FSA/EOC testing window begins on Monday, April 4th and will continue until Friday, May 27th. Schedules will be sent via Parent Link messages to parents, and teachers will provide students with their testing dates & times as well. Our first exam, FSA Writing, has been scheduled by teacher/period and is also posted on the FLHS school website under testing.





Keep your files backed up in case something happens to your PC.

Right Click the OneDrive icon -> Settings->Backup->Manage backup. It will allow you to backup files from your desktop, documents, or pictures folders. Select the locations you want backed up and hit start backup. Once the backup is done, you'll be able to access your files from the OneDrive web app or another PC that is signed in using your P#.
