


What is the Cambridge AICE Program?

The Advanced International Certificate of Education program (AICE) is an International Pre-University Program, part of the Cambridge Assessment Group, a not for profit organization and a department of the University of England. Pre-AICE courses taken will prepare student for the AICE level courses. AICE level courses culminates with a Cambridge exam. Students can earn college credit for passing scores in every AICE-level exam taken.

# FAQ's

- 1. What are the eligibility requirements for Cambridge AICE program?

  Student must have at least a level 3 on the FSA Reading test to participate.
- 2. How will earning the AICE diploma benefit my student?
  In addition to demonstrating rigor to post-secondary institutions, AICE diploma recipients will be eligible for the top tier Bright Futures Scholarship (100% tuition).
- 3. How well-known and wide spread is the AICE program?
  More than 9,000 schools offer Cambridge worldwide. Over 130 schools in Florida and 200 across the U.S offer the AICE program. All 11 public colleges in the state of Florida and over 450 private and out of state universities accept the AICE credits by exam.

- 4. Where does the course content for AICE courses come from?

  AICE courses follow a course syllabus that is designed by Cambridge International Examinations.
- 5. When do students take AICE exams?
  Students will take exams May and June,
  depending on the course. Students have 25
  months to satisfy the requires for AICE
  diploma once first exam is taken.
- 6. What is considered a passing score om the AICE exam?

  Exams grades of A-E are considered passing. Other scores are not considered passing.
