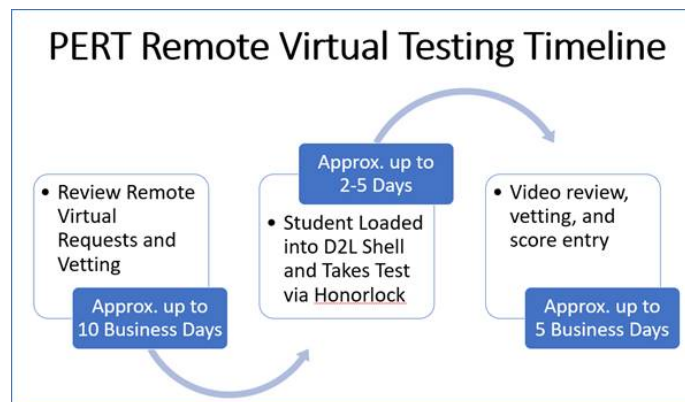


## Dual Enrollment – Remote Testing – Fall Term 2020

### Student Directions

- 1) Apply to BC Online if you have not already at [www.broward.edu](http://www.broward.edu).
  - 2) Obtain DE Testing Referral Form filled out from your counselor.
  - 3) Go to [www.broward.edu/remote](http://www.broward.edu/remote).
  - 4) Click on “**Remote Virtual**” next to **Option 1**.
  - 5) Read the page of information on remote testing.
  - 6) Click on “**Remote Virtual Request Form**” at the bottom of the page.
  - 7) Complete and submit your request online.
  - 8) Information will be emailed to you from the testing center on how to get started and when you can do your exam.
- As a reminder, the ACCUPLACER (**CPT** and **HLM**) is still unavailable.
  - The PERT exam is accessed through D2L and uses Honorlock for proctoring. At the conclusion of testing, testing proctors are reviewing the video of the student to make sure no testing irregularities or cheating occurred. If no issues are found, the testing staff will then enter the scores into the BC System.
    - The timeline image below shows the estimated timing for this process as it is extremely labor intensive.



- Students must have the appropriate technology to take the exam through D2L and Honorlock such as the correct browser and webcam with microphone. Below are the various compatibility check links.
