Cultural Geography

- Pre-AP Course (Honors Credit for GPA)
- Covers roughly 80% of AP curriculum
- Vocabulary-centric
- 12% higher pass rate for students who took the course and then went on to take AP Human Geography (compared to global average)
- 67% of students who took the course prior to AP Human Geography earned a 4 or 5 on the 2017-2018 AP exam
- Program led to the highest pass rate in Broward County for the 2018-2019 school year

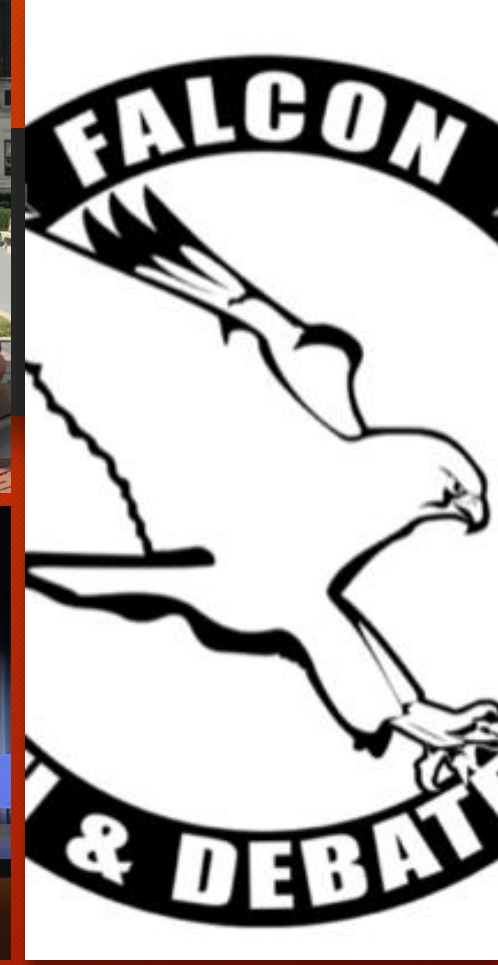

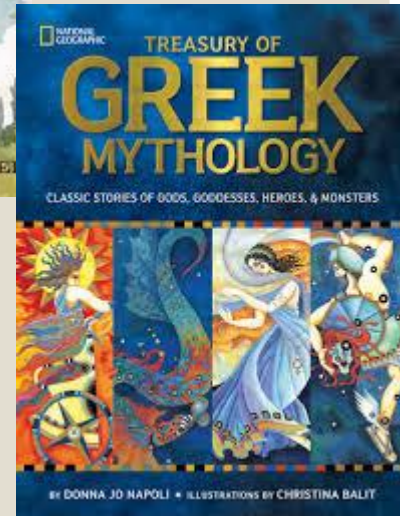
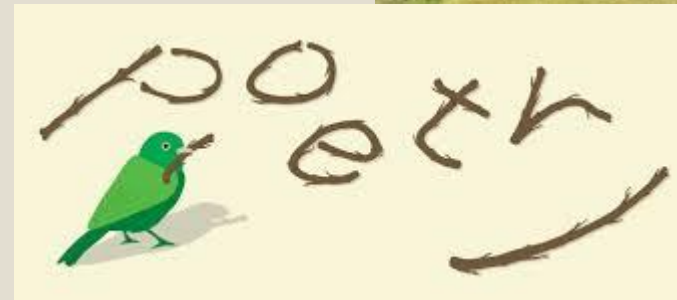

NJROTC teaches leadership, citizenship, government, wellness, fitness, first aid (including diet, exercise, drug awareness), and the history and traditions of the U.S. Navy. After school activities are Drill Competition, Air Rifle, Orienteering, Academic Competitions, Robotics (land/water), Drone.

Literature Through the Ages

- This course focuses on literature through the ages and its representations from text through various media.
- Explores the changes that occur in narrative adaptations from print to visual forms throughout history.
- We investigate and discuss how classic works are portrayed culturally and allow for an appreciation of cultural differences.
- Students view a variety of video, film, lyric, and artistic material within the course.
- Working cooperatively, students present new knowledge to their classmates.
- Students receive Honors credit.
