





# BCPS Dual Enrollment Guidelines 2021-2022 School Year

Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) supports all students having the option to undertake higher education credit earning opportunities while in high school. We currently offer College Board Advanced Placement (AP), Cambridge-AICE, International Baccalaureate (IB), and Dual Enrollment (DE) options. Historically, the cost of dual enrollment has exceeded the allocated budget due to student enrollment growth and mid-year adjustments. At this time, BCPS is implementing constraints on the number of dual enrollment courses that a student may take so that the total expenditure does not exceed the allocated budget in any fiscal year. At this time, schools will be using the proposed dual enrollment limitations to schedule students. These proposed constraints prioritize juniors and seniors, students near graduation, and enable an appeal process.

## For the Fall of 2021:

#### **GRADES 6-10**

- Can take ONE class each semester at BC, FAU, or UF Online.
- They can take the class on the high school campus (if offered) or on the college campus.

### **GRADE 11**

- Can take a total of two (2) classes each semester. **HOWEVER....** 
  - a) They can **only** take **ONE** class each semester on the BC campus, online through BC, on the FAU campus, online at FAU, or online at UF.
  - b) They can take the second DE course on your high school campus if you offer DE courses on your high school campus.
  - c) If you do not have any DE courses on your campus, or if the student is not interested in taking the DE course on your campus then that student would only be allowed to take a total of ONE class each semester on the BC campus, online through BC, on the FAU campus, online at FAU, or online at UF.

#### **GRADE 12**

- Can take a total of three (3) classes each semester. **HOWEVER....** 
  - a) They can **only** take <u>TWO</u> classes each semester on the BC campus, online through BC, on the FAU campus, online at FAU, or online at UF.
  - b) They can take the third DE course on your high school campus if you offer DE courses on your high school campus.
  - c) If you do not have any DE courses on your campus, or if the student is not interested in taking the DE course on your campus then that student would only be allowed to take a total of TWO classes each semester on the BC campus, online through BC, on the FAU campus, online at FAU, or online at UF.
- Early Admissions Students:
  - a) Are limited to taking a maximum of 15 Credit Hours per semester.
