# Información General AP y AICE

- Los estudiantes pueden tomar clases AP y AICE simultáneamente.
- Los estudiantes obtienen 2 puntos de calidad en GPA para clases AP y AICE.
- Los estudiantes pueden obtener créditos universitarios si aprueban los exámenes AICE o AP.

## Diferencias con el Programa AICE:

- Los estudiantes pueden obtener un Diploma AICE
- Los estudiantes que obtengan un Diploma AICE y 100 horas de servicio comunitario calificarán para Bright Futures - Florida Academic Scholar Award sin puntajes calificados de SAT/ACT.
- Los estudiantes pueden eximir a HOPE y al requisito de graduación en línea al completar el plan de estudios de AICE.

# Requisito de Diploma AICE

Los estudiantes deben obtener 7 créditos al aprobar y completar 7 cursos AICE con la combinación de exámenes de nivel AS (1 crédito) o nivel A (1 crédito) en un período de 25 meses a partir de junio del año de su primer examen.


El **ÚNICO** curso de nivel A que se ofrece por 2 créditos es **Thinking Skills**. Un mínimo de un examen debe provenir de cada una de las 3 áreas temáticas:

- Matemáticas y Ciencias
- Artes del Lenguaje (incluye Idiomas Extranjeros)
- Artes y Humanidades

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

### The Advanced International Certificate of Education program (AICE)

is an innovative and accelerated method of academic study offered solely through the University of Cambridge International Examination. In this program, students take Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) 9-12 courses and can earn an international diploma if they accrue at least 7 points by passing AICE exams within a three-year period (25 months from the first exam to the last exam). Students must take a class in each of the three groups, math and science, languages, arts, humanities and Global Perspective.



**Cambridge Assessment International Education**

#### Flexible, broad and balanced:

By demanding knowledge from three different subject groups, the Cambridge AICE Diploma provides a broad curriculum with a balance of math and science, languages, arts and humanities. It still maintains flexibility and choice by allowing students to pick specific subjects and levels.

#### General Questions:

A Cambridge diploma guarantees a Bright Future ACADEMIC tuition scholarship, the highest Bright Futures awards possible, without having to meet some other requirements such as ACT/SAT scores.

Students can have any combinations of regular, honors, AICE, or AP courses.

University of Cambridge International Examinations publishes a list on its website of US universities that have provided written statements of their AICE (which includes AS and A Levels) recognition policy. EXAMS are offered in November, May and June (they may occur after school is out).




