

Cooper City High School Profile - Class of 2019

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School

Cooper City High School (CCHS) is located in Cooper City, FL and is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. CCHS is a comprehensive public school, nationally acclaimed as a Blue Ribbon School and one of America's Best High Schools by *The Washington Post* and *Newsweek* – 74th in Florida and 1380 in the nation. Moreover, the school has been recognized by Broward County Public Schools for its 99% graduation rate – one of the highest in the county – and by the state of Florida for the 5-Star School Award. CCHS has 2340 students, grades 9 through 12, with a culturally diverse population: 46% White, 34% Hispanic/Latino, 12% Black, 4% Asian and 4% Multi-racial or Other. Cooper City High School offers 24 Advanced Placement classes as well as 46 honors classes, in addition to the AICE Cambridge Program, which began this year. Advanced Placement and Dual Enrollment

In 2019, 558 CCHS students took over 1346 AP tests in 24 subjects, and 62% scored 3 or higher. Also, 12 students received an AP Capstone Diploma. In 2019, 219 students took Dual Enrollment courses and 21 students were Early Admission students at Broward College, Florida Atlantic University and University of Florida.

Weighting of Grades

All subjects are given grades and credit. Grades in courses which are labeled honors, Advanced Placement or Dual Enrollment receive extra quality points when students earn a "C" or better. The school district determines class rank based upon the weighted GPA that is officially recalculated each semester.

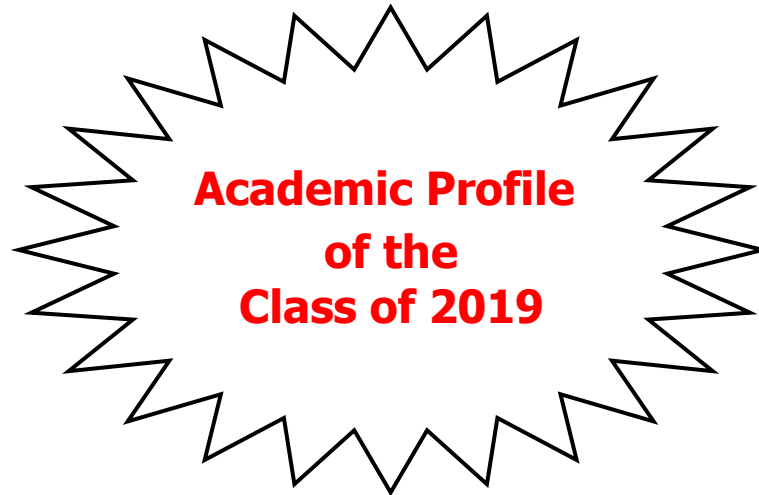
