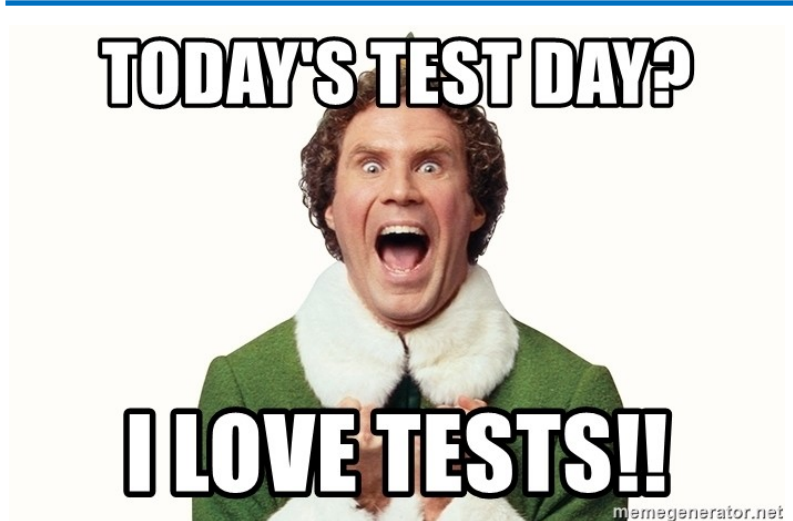

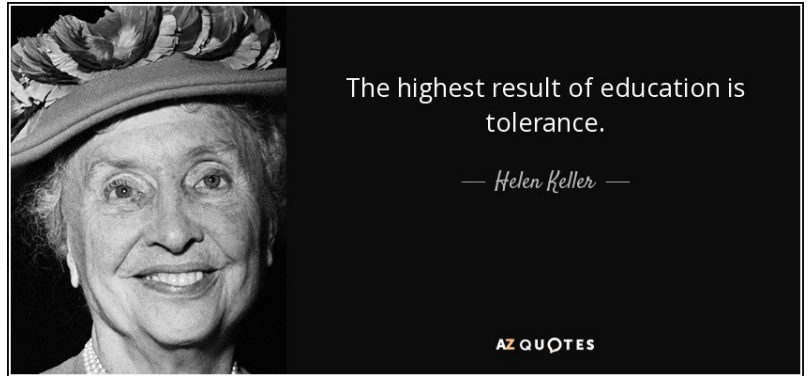

- Having a positive relationship with peers

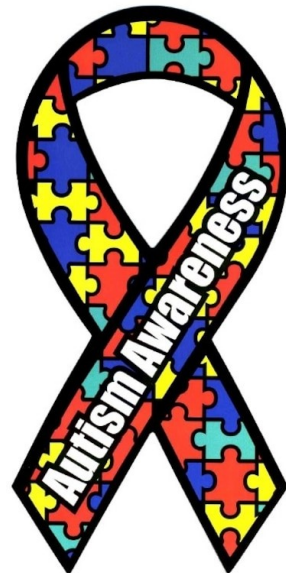
