Students have only 3 years to complete the seven exams.

Our current 9th graders would be completed with the AICE diploma by the end of their junior year.

Our current 10th graders would be completed with the AICE diploma by the end of their senior year.

Benefits of AICE



All passed exams receive college credit for the course in addition to high school credit.



All AICE exams get two extra quality points in the weighted GPA.



Students that obtain the Cambridge Diploma automatically receive (regardless of SAT/ACT score) the Bright Futures Academic Scholarship.




The Bright Futures Academic Scholarship pays 100% of tuition and books at any State University in Florida.

A Cambridge mathematics course is not required to obtain the Cambridge diploma.

The expectation is that all Lauderhill 6-12 Magnet High School students will be diligent in all requirements for the Cambridge program.




Pre-AICE Cambridge Middle School Accelerated Progression (Lower Secondary)
