



## **YFF** Criteria

I understand that I am responsible for keeping up with all assigned course work required as part of this agreement.

- I understand I will take the high school midterm and final exam for each high school course I am enrolled in for the 22-23 school year.
- I understand that I must follow all regulations and guidelines established for high school courses.
- I understand that grades for students taking high school courses in middle school will be included in all high school G.P.A.s, including the weighted high school grade point average used to determine class rank.
- I understand that if I am experiencing difficulty in a high school course, I must initiate a conference with the Flanagan Guidance Department.
- I understand that I may drop the course within the first 21 days of enrollment. If I do not, I am committing to finishing the course and accepting the grade I earn.
- I understand that I must have a score of at least a 3 on the FSA Assessments for both Reading and Math to participate.

- I understand that I am expected to maintain a 3.0 GPA while in this program.
- I understand that I must have passed all 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade classes in order to participate.





- Students receive Honors credit.



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
