## What is Title I?

- Title I is the largest federal assistance program for our nation's schools.
- The goal of Title I is a higher quality of education for <u>every</u> child.
- The program serves millions of children in elementary and secondary schools each year. Driftwood Middle School is a Title I school

### How does Title I work?

- The federal government provides funding to states each year for Title I.
- The Florida Department of Education sends the money to the district.
- The school district identifies eligible schools and provides Title I funds.

# Title I Programs Provides Supplemental Services

- Smaller classes;
- Additional teachers and paraprofessionals;
- Additional training for school staff;
- Extra time for instruction (Before and/or after school programs);
- Parental Engagement Activities; and/or
- A variety of supplemental teaching methods and materials.
