Dear Parent/Guardian,

During this school year, every Nova Middle School student had the opportunity to pick up an iPad with data, a charging cable, a power adapter, and a Verizon bookbag. As we move closer to the end of the school year it is now time to collect the devices.

We will collect ALL student iPads, charging cables and adapters by grade level. Beginning on April 28, 2021, students who are learning from school, will return their equipment during their grade level lunches.

Students learning from home, will return their devices during their scheduled FSA (Florida Standards Assessment) Testing dates. Below you will find all iPad return dates and instructions for each grade level. Please take a few minutes to review this information with your child in preparation for your assigned iPad drop-off day.

Grade Level	Date	FSA Test
6 th	May 3 rd and 4 th	Reading and Math
7 th	May 5 th , 6 th , and 7 th	Reading, Math, and Civics
8 th	May 10 th ,11 th , and 12th	Reading, Math, and Science

We are asking students to please place the iPad and charger in a one-gallon Ziploc bag and to write their first name, last name, student number, and grade level outside the bag with a permanent marker.

It is the responsibility of the parents and students to return their school issued iPad device and charging equipment on their assigned date. Failure to return the device and/or charging equipment will result in the following obligations: iPad Device: \$429.00 and charging adapter and block: \$38.
