District GPA = Weighted GPA includes quantity points for advanced classes

State GPA = Unweighted GPA raw score with no quantity points for advanced classes

Core GPA = Weighted GPA of core classes and foreign language includes .5 quality for advanced classes

Rank is determined by highest Weighted GPA and includes all classes.
