What is Title I?

- It is the largest federal assistance program for our nation's schools.
- The goal is to provide higher quality education for *every* child.
- The program serves millions of students each year.
- Coral Park is a Title I school.

How Title I Works

- Federal government provides funds
- Florida Department of Education sends the funds to the District
- District identifies eligible schools and provides the Title I funds

How Title I Funds Work

- Used to provide additional resources and support to students and parents.
- Additional teachers and/or paraprofessionals
- Additional training for staff
- Extra time for instruction (before/after school programs)
- Variety of supplemental teaching methods/materials
- Parent and Family Engagement Activities

Standards & Testing

- Primary focus is standards-based instruction
- Establish high expectations for all students
- Identify what your child needs to know/do
- Grade level expectations from Teachers to follow at later date
