PEMBROKE PINES 2021 SENIOR PARADE FLANAGAN HIGH SCHOOL

Thank you for participating in the City of Pembroke Pines *Flanagan High School Graduation Parade on Saturday, June 5 at 11:00A.M.* Below are the guidelines for the event for parents and students.

General Information

- Only one vehicle per graduate; family must ride in the car with the graduate. No spectators will be allowed on the parade route
- Only personal vehicles are allowed: no limousines, trailers, commercial vehicles, etc.
- Participants are not allowed to ride in the back of pick-up trucks or exit their vehicle during the parade.
- Participants are encouraged to decorate your vehicle, bring noise makers, etc.
- Bring an index card with your full name (spelled phonetically).
- Bring your school ID.
- Please adhere to social distancing guidelines.
- Please be aware that there will be no access to restrooms. There are port-o-lets in the staging area.

<u>Parade Staging</u>

- Parade Staging will be located in the parking lots of City Center. Staging will begin at 10:15AM.
- Pull your vehicle up to the "City of Pembroke Pines" tent and provide your Student ID.
- You will be directed where to go from there.
- While in the staging area participants must keep their windows up and may not exit their vehicle.

Parade Route

- The parade route will be around the City Center building.
- Pembroke Pines Police Department and/or event staff will direct you when to enter your vehicle into the parade line.
- Do not exit your vehicle at any point during the parade.
- Do not throw candy or any items from vehicles.

<u>City Center</u>

- City Center will NOT be open to the general public. Entry is restricted to parade vehicles, school staff, City staff and City officials only.
- Do not exit the vehicle at any time.
- While going through the parade route, staff will retrieve the index card with your name so that the emcee can announce you.
- Once the route is complete, please exit Washington Avenue headed westbound.
