Spectators are not permitted to carry backpacks into event venues. Please see the attached bag policy for all sporting events. Increased law enforcement and security presence will continue at sporting events, and there will be no re-admittance.

Trained security personnel will continue to conduct screenings with handheld metal detectors at high school and middle school sporting events. In addition, tickets at football and basketball games will not be sold after the start of the 4th quarter.

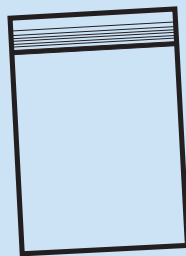
The District thanks everyone for their cooperation to ensure BCPS provides safe environments for everyone attending District sporting events.

Approved spectator bags for on campus events



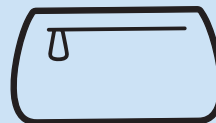
CLEAR TOTE BAG
