
## January-February Update

For students who are participating in face to face instruction at school, please know that CDC guideline protocols are in place, and we are grateful for the cooperation of everyone in adherence to these protocols. Students who are learning by way of face to face instruction will need to wear a face mask, basic school supplies (paper, pen, and pencil), personal hand sanitizer, their laptop, charger, and headphones on a daily basis. The district has eased the dress code policy at this time so students do not need to wear school uniforms but must dress in appropriate learning attire (no bonnets, tank tops, ripped jeans).

In an effort to maximize academic learning, it is the expectation for ALL students who are participating in face to face instruction to attend school in the physical building every day. If a student is sick, however, please keep the child/children home and contact the school and teacher regarding his or her absence. Make sure the school has a working number for parent/guardian available as soon as possible in the event we need to make contact due to illness.
