success that has been happening here for many years. I hold a B.A. in History and Global Studies

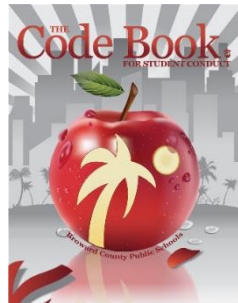

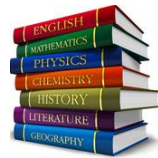
NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION

STUDENT ID BADGES



ALL Everglades High School students will be issued an ID badge. Students must ALWAYS wear their ID badge AROUND THEIR NECK while on campus. It is the individual student's responsibility to maintain and display their ID badge. From 7:00 AM – 7:40 AM, students entering the southwest end (student lot) of the campus who do not have their ID will be directed to room 243 where they will be provided a temporary ID. From 7:00 AM – 7:40 AM, students entering the north end (bus loop) of the campus who do not have their ID will be directed to the front office where they will be provided a temporary ID. If a student arrives to class without an ID, the teacher will submit a Temporary ID Request Form. A temporary ID will be generated and delivered to the student in a timely fashion. The first four temporary IDs will be provided FREE of charge after which, students will be charged \$1 each. Replacement IDs will cost \$5 and a lanyard will be available for \$2.

STUDENT ATTENDANCE



Students that arrive late to school for 1st and 5th period will be marked tardy by the front office. These students will be issued a tardy pass and sent to class as soon as possible. For the remaining periods, a warning bell will ring one minute before the final bell to encourage students to get to class on time. In addition...

- Administration and security will make every effort to guide students to class.
- Hall passes will not be issued the first or final 15-minutes of class. This includes Study Hall classes.
- Teachers will document tardy students in Pinnacle.
- Appropriate interventions, including detentions, parent contact, loss of privileges, etc. will be implemented to discourage chronic tardiness.

FOOD DELIVERIES FOR STUDENTS



Broward County Public Schools are closed campuses. Students ARE NOT PERMITTED to order food items to be delivered to school campuses. **Any violation of this policy will result in the immediate confiscation and discarding of the food item.** Unauthorized visitors are not allowed on Broward County Public Schools property for the delivery of student ordered meals.

DRESS FOR SUCCESS



Student dress should be in accordance with standards established by School Board policy (see the student code of conduct). Egregious violations of the policy will be addressed by school administration. In the event of a violation, parents will be contacted to bring a change of clothing and/or the student will be provided with a school-issued garment. A \$5 obligation will be assessed.
