SAFETY & SECURITY



- Starting August 12, all BCPS high school students will be screened through metal detectors. Carefully read important information at <u>https://www.browardschools.com/metaldet</u> ectors
 - 1. All students and visitors must pass through metal detectors to enter the school.
 - 2. STUDENTS WILL NEED TO PRESENT THEIR ID BEFORE BEING SCREENED.
 - The new metal detectors are calibrated so students cn pass through with their backpacks and personal belongings.

- 4. Parents should remind students to bring only necessary items and ensure they do not bring weapons or other prohibited items to school.
- ID badge must always be worn and visibly displayed by students, faculty, and staff while on campus.
- Upon entry to campus, all visitors must be cleared through the Raptor system. This includes but is not limited to, parents, district staff, vendors, volunteers, and members of the public. Official photo identification will be requested. Your name, date of visit, time of arrival, purpose for visit, and time of departure will be reported in a visitor's log.
- <u>Food deliveries by outside companies (i.e.</u> <u>Uber Eats) are prohibited.</u>

SCHEDULE CHANGE PROCESS

The schedule change window will be open from Monday, August 19th at 2:45pm until Friday, August 23th at 2:45pm.

No exceptions will be made for students that fail to submit a request by the deadline.

Schedule change requests will only be reviewed if the "Back to School" form has been completed in the Focus Parent Portal. Proof of completion must be uploaded to receive any change. A link will be posted to CANVAS on August 19th at 2:45pm. The School Counseling Department will not accept schedule changes via email or phone call. A submission does not mean a schedule change is guaranteed.

Please note that changes will be made on a limited basis, and when space permits. When requesting a change, please keep in mind that it may result in adjusting **multiple courses** on your schedule. Teachers will also provide the School Counselors with a list of student names that are academically misplaced in **CORE** classes. Please continue to complete all the work in your current classes, since you cannot be certain that a change will be made.

ONLY elective schedule changes will be reviewed; if students are academically misplaced, communicate with the teacher. If you believe you are in the wrong core class (English, Math, Science, or Social Studies), please tell your teacher immediately.

Your schedule change request will be handled in the order in which it was received. School Counselors will advise you if the schedule change has been granted by Monday, August 26.

Any student who registered for a bus last year and did not use the service, must register for a bus using their student 06 account.

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Mobile Duress Alert App

Alyssa's Alert is a mobile duress alert application that empowers staff members to immediately notify first responders in the event of an emergency. Receive potentially life-saving aid with the push of a button.

Speed Crisis Response

Upon activation*, local first responders & District personnel receive an immediate notification of the emergency.

Easy to Use

Select one of the three buttons (shown right) to activate Alyssa's Alert. Assistance will immediately be dispatched to your location.**

Stav Connected

Administrators will be able to push important updates regarding an emergency situation to anyone who has downloaded Alyssa's Alert.

Duress buttons can only be activated while physically on school property. "ONLY first responders may access location information upon button activation. Under no other circumstances is location information accessible
