INNOVATIVE PROGRAMS

CAMBRIDGE ACADEMY



The Cambridge Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) Diploma is an international curriculum and examination system that emphasizes the value of broad and balanced study. Alongside an in-depth understanding of a variety of subjects, students also master a broader range of skills critical for success in university study and employment. This rigorous program will give our students a competitive edge when applying to top-fier colleges and universities. Students also earn college credits for passing AICE exams and will earn a Bright Futures scholarship for earning the AICE Diploma.



REDESIGNED: EXERCISE SCIENCE



The Exercise Science program is designed for highly motivated students interested in exploring a career in Exercise Science or Sports Medicine. In this rigarous program, students will take courses in Health Science A&P, Health Science Foundations, Medical Skills, and Exercise Science. Students will have the opportunity to earn their Certified Medical Administrative Assistant (CMAA) Industry Certification



FIRE ACADEMY

Instructors from the City of Miramar Fire Department offer Everglades High School a dynamic firefighter curriculum during the school day. Students participate in exciting experiential learning both in and out of the classroom. The Fire Academy is a 3-year program. This program is open to 10th, 11th, and 12th grade students. Graduates can earn a Level 1 State Firefighter Certification.



NEW: APPLIED CYBERSECURITY



The Applied Cybersecurity pathway will teach students the tools and systems used to monitor, mitigate, and prevent online threats. Cybersecurity professionals use innovative technology for combart hackers, cyberterrorists, network outages, and other technical problems that compromise network security. Students in this program will take courses in information technology (IT) fundamentals, computer and network security fundamentals, cybersecurity respectively. computer and network security freesentials, and operational cybersecurity.



PROJECT RED



Project RED is our Rigorous Engineering and Design Program. Highly Motivated students survey the field of engineering as they become proficient in various gold-standard engineering programs and work with specialized equipment such as 3D printers, dye-sublimation printers, CRC Mills, and robotics. Students can earn several industry certifications in this 4-year program.



FBI/ LAW ENFORCEMENT ACADEMY



This program improves students' understanding of the law and law enforcement through ongoing partnerships between our school, the FBI, the DEA, and our local law enforcement agency. Students in this program will learn about the duties of federal agents and local officers while building relationships that could lead to career opportunities. Guests from various agencies provide our students a glimpse of life as a law enforcement professional.







Mobile Duress Alert App

Alyssa's Alert is a mobile duress alert application that empowers staff members to immediately notify first responders in the event of an emergency. Receive potentially life-saving aid with the push of a button.

Speed Crisis Response

Upon activation*, local first responders & District personnel receive an immediate notification of the emergency.

Easy to Use

Select one of the three buttons (shown right) to activate Alyssa's Alert. Assistance will immediately be dispatched to your location.**

Stay Connected

Administrators will be able to push important updates regarding an emergency situation to anyone who has downloaded Alyssa's Alert.

*Duress buttons can only be activated while physically on school property: **ONLY first responders may access location information upon button activation. Under no other circumstances is location information
