

## NEW STUDENT Dual Enrollment Checklist



**STEP 1:** Verify with your counselor that you have:

- minimum 3.0 unweighted high school grade point average (GPA)
- minimum College-level test scores or College Readiness using Alternative Methods of Placement in all areas - Writing/English, Reading, and Math: https://www.broward.edu/academics/dual-enrollment/eligibility-requirements.html

**STEP 2:** Complete a Broward College application. Apply as a dual enrollment student. After you apply, you will receive an email with your <u>BC username (email)</u> and <u>BC Student ID number</u>. It may take up to 24 hours to receive the email and for the system to allow you to log in with your BC credentials.

**STEP 3A:** Complete the **Broward College Dual Enrollment Parent/Legal Guardian Form.** Only legal signatures will be accepted. No typed fonts will be accepted as a signature. Once the form is signed and submitted by you, your form will be routed to the school you chose (Nova High School) on the form for review and approval.

**STEP 4:** You will receive an email from Ms. Mainer, our Dual Enrollment Liaison, with the next steps.

**STEP 5:** On registration day, log in to your BC One Access account and register for your approved course(s).

**STEP 6:** Print a copy of your schedule and attach it to the **Nova High School Dual Enrollment Student-Parent Agreement Form**.
