# Nova High School AICE Diploma Course Progression



The AICE curriculum requires a total of **SEVEN** AICE courses between grades 9-11 or grades 10-12 with at least one course and one exam from each of the three subject groups, as well as one in the core group (Global Perspectives & Research). Students may take as many AICE courses as desired if there is a teacher recommendation and the minimum requirement (7) is met. Advanced Subsidiary Level (AS) exams count as one point toward the diploma. Advanced Level (A) exams count as an additional point toward the diploma. Students must earn the seven required credits within 25 months of taking the first AICE exam(s).
