Words of the Week - Science

Monday - Producer/Autotroph

Organisms that capture energy from the sun to make their own food; Possess the most energy in a food web;

Example: Plants

Tuesday - Consumer/Heterotroph

Organisms that acquire energy from other organisms;

Examples: Tigers, Humans, Elephants

Wednesday - Decomposer

Organisms that obtain energy by eating dead and decaying plants and animal

Examples: some bacteria, earthworms, fungi

Thursday - Renewable Resource

Resources that nature can make more of as quickly as we use it

Examples: Sunlight, Wind, Hydroelectric Power

Non-renewable Resource

Resources that will eventually run out;

Examples: Oil, Coal
