All local honors courses are designated with "LH" in the title.

Opportunities for Dual Enrollment are available through Broward College and the University of Florida.

Personal Financial Literacy is a new graduation requirement for students who entered 9th grade in school years 2021-2022 and After. PBHS students are encouraged to take this course on FLVS. This course is also offered through Dual Enrollment at Broward College.
