

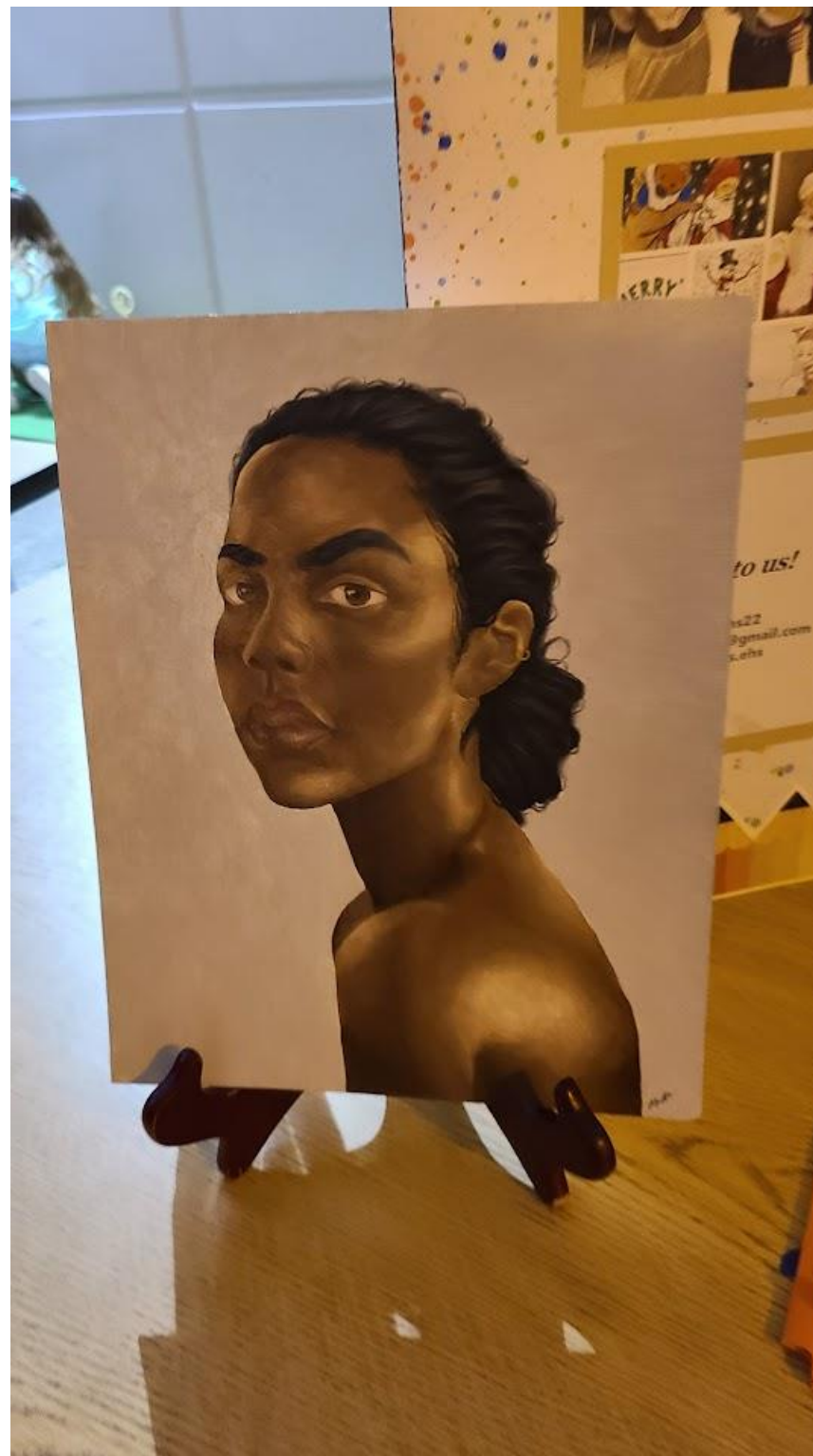

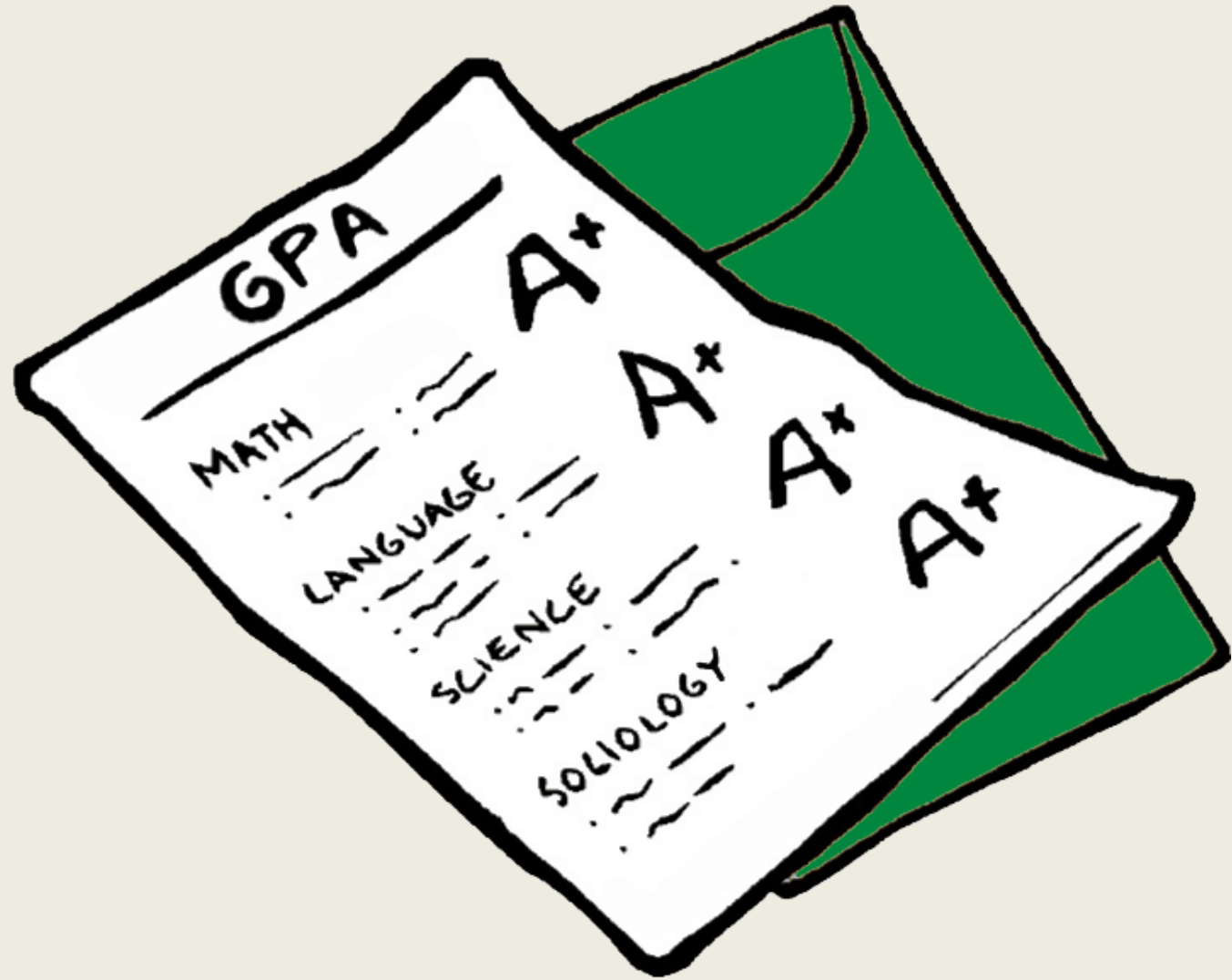

# BELL SCHEDULE

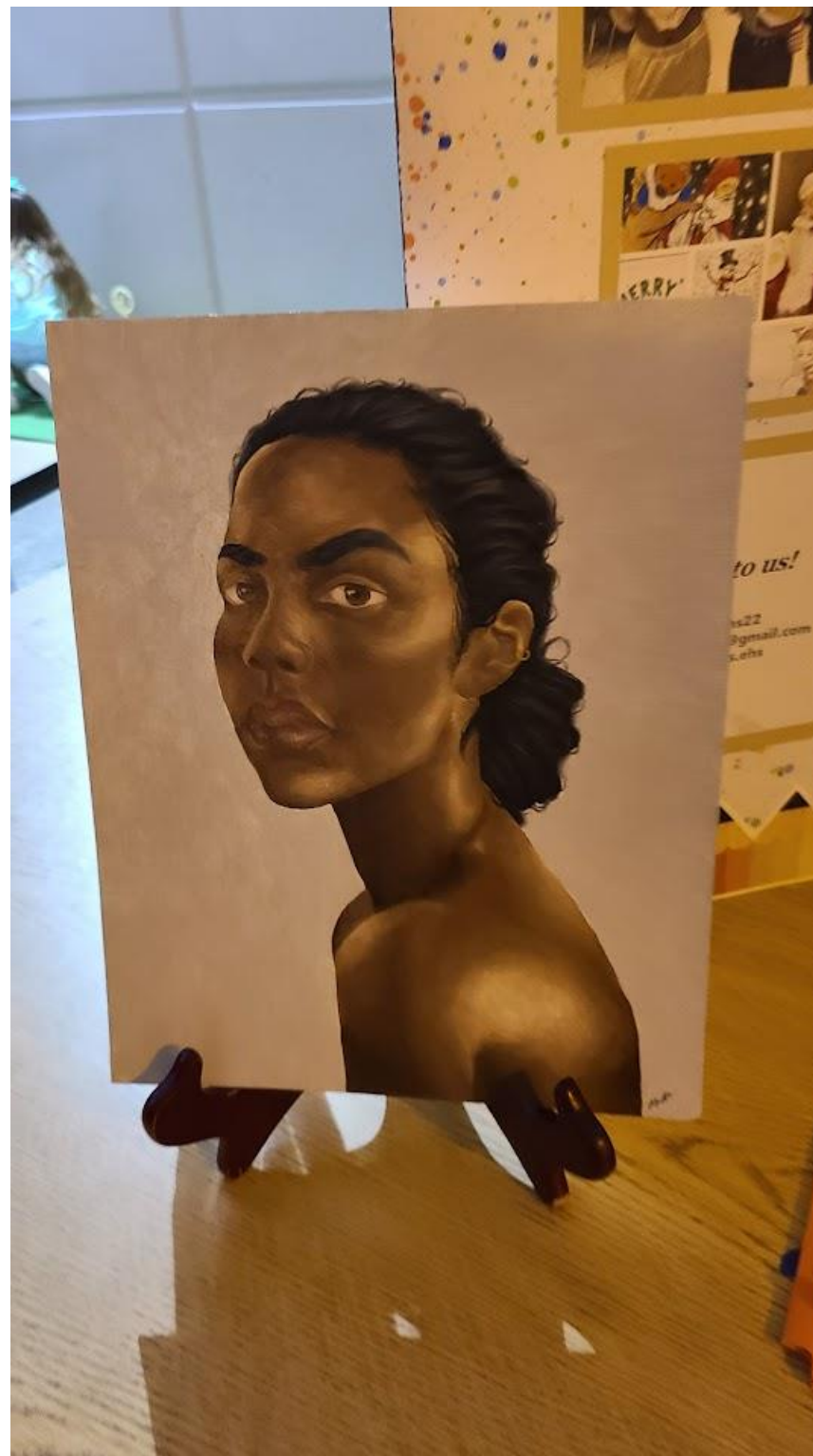

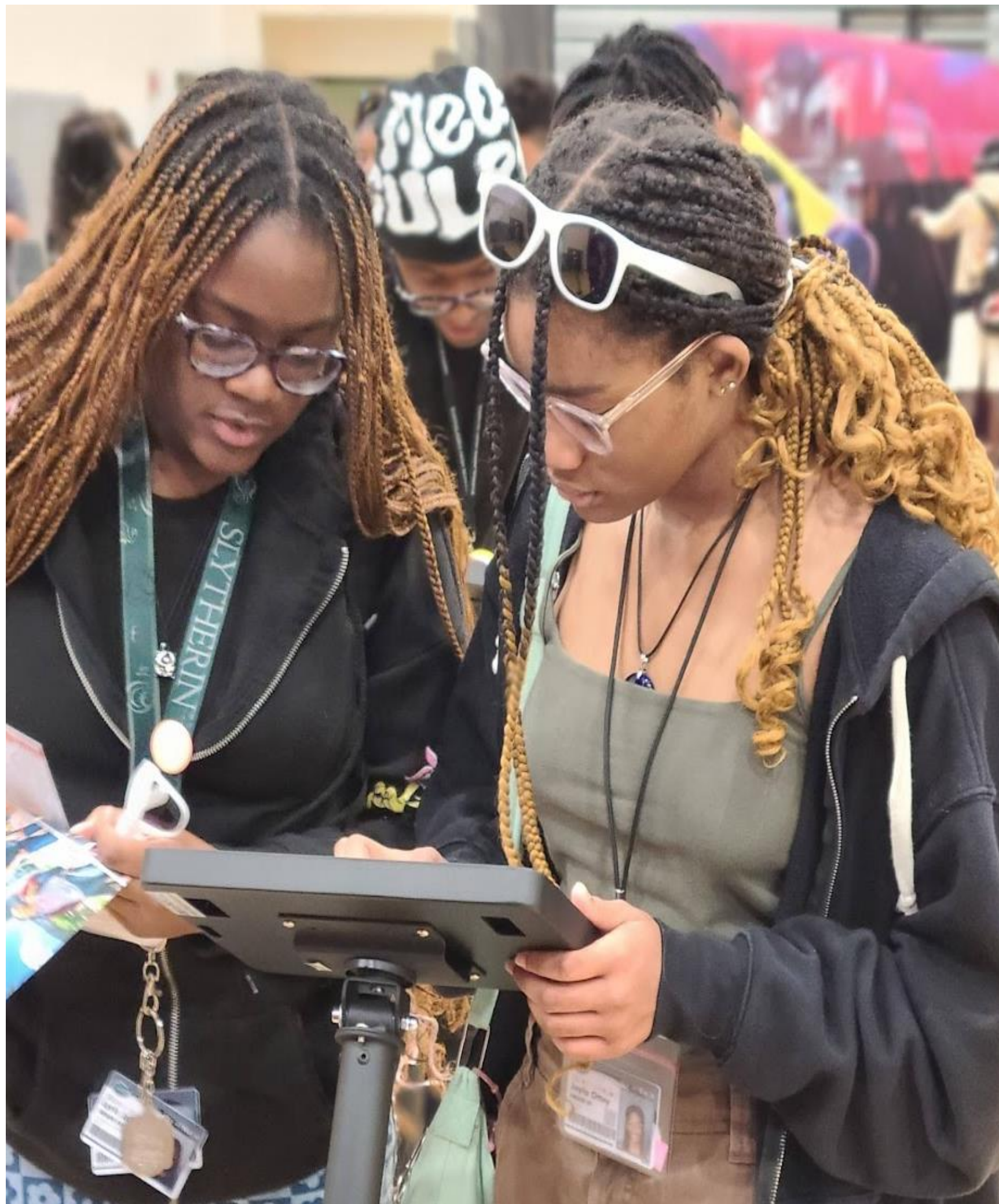




# INSTRUMENTAL TECHNIQUES I

This course focuses on the development of musical and technical skills on a specific instrument through etudes, scales, and selected music literature. Public performances may serve as a culmination of specific instructional goals.

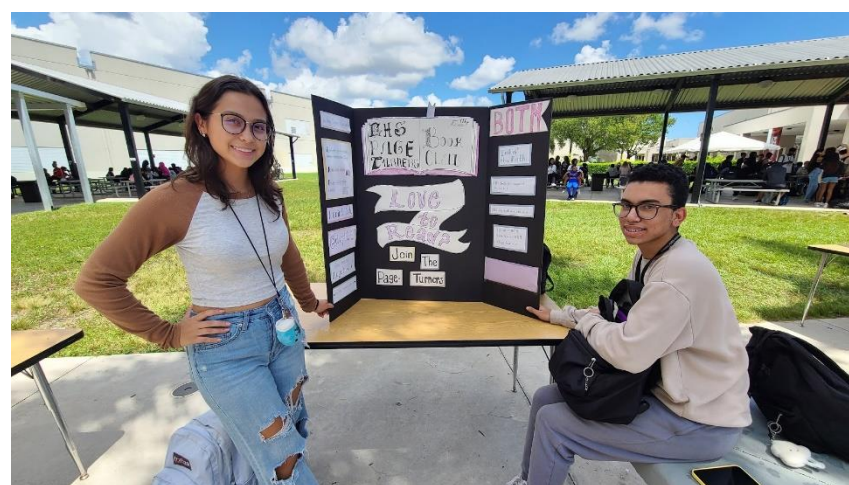
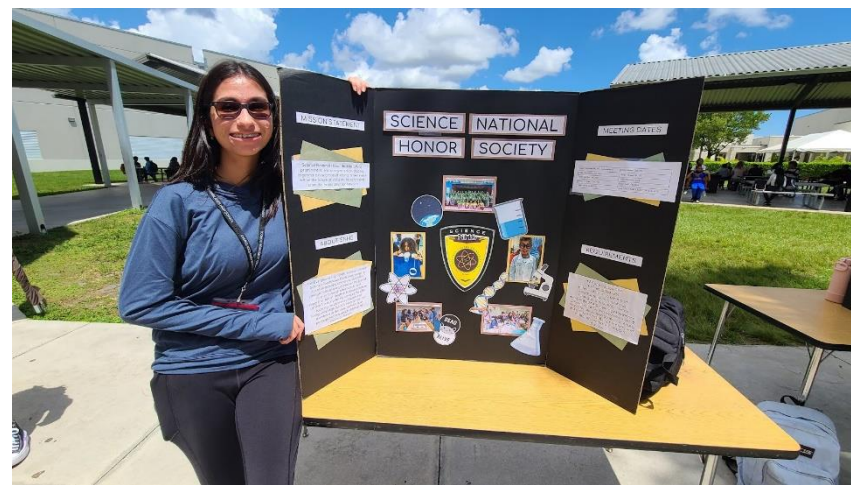
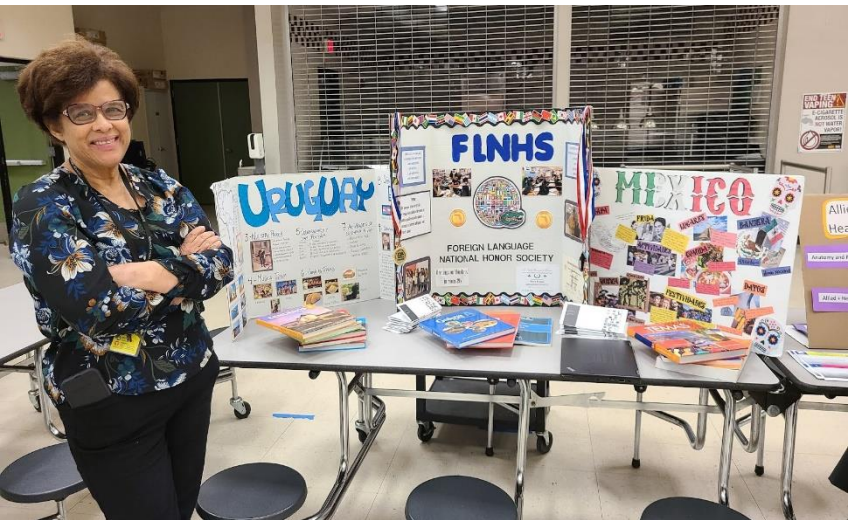




# IT FUNDAMENTALS
