As a resolution to a discriminatory complaint filed with the Office for Civil Rights; the attached flyer has been created in an effort to ensure that our parents, as well as, the general public are aware of who they can contact with questions regarding Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Section 504).

As you are aware, Section 504 prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability in any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance. Additionally, Section 504 enables educational accommodations for students with disabilities who are not eligible for services under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).

The posting of this flyer is mandatory and must be placed on your school's bulletin board in your school, where parents and other members of the public may have access.
