**CAPTAIN
BARRINGTON IRVING**

Captain Barrington Irving loves exploring, inspiring, and teaching. At 23, he became the youngest and first black pilot to fly solo around the world. Cpt. Barrington has conducted over 30 STEM expeditions around the world. He founded the Flying Classroom, a K-8 STEM+ digital curriculum, in 2014. Experience Aviation, his nonprofit, provides hands-on STEM programs and career guidance to middle and high school students in several states. Cpt. Barrington received a Congressional Resolution and was named a National Geographic Emerging Explorer in 2012.

Robens Chery, the founder and CEO of Principle Life Youth Development, encourages young people to make better choices in their relationships and education. For over ten years, Mr. Chery has spoken to teenagers in South Florida public and private schools, churches, and basketball camps. He was a former teacher and a grant liaison for Broward County Public Schools. Mr. Chery is the author of the book, Teen Mindset, which addresses current teen issues like education, self-worth, acceptance, relationships, identity, decision-making, bullying, and values.
